BOULDER CREEK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT CAPITAL ASSET INVESTMENT AND MANAGEMENT POLICY

Purpose:

Capital assets have a major impact on the ability of the District to deliver services. They support the economic vitality and overall quality of life for Boulder Creek residents and surrounding communities. The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for capital planning, budgeting, project management and maintenance.

Policy:

A. Roles and Process of the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) – The Fire Chief, with Board direction, is responsible for coordinating the CIP process and compiling the CIP document.

Other key roles include:

- 1. CIP Each year the Fire Chief shall develop a six-year long-range CIP that describes and prioritizes the capital projects the District intends to undertake.
- 2. Review of Capital Project Proposals The Fire Chief will coordinate a financial Capital Project review process within the annual budget calendar.
 - a. Full Consideration of Operating and Maintenance Costs Adequate resources should be identified to operate and maintain existing assets.
 - b. Project Evaluation System During the review cycle, the Fire Chief will propose projects and request funding. The Board of Directors will review these requests and rank them by priority.
 - c. Stakeholder Participation The District shall provide meaningful opportunities for stakeholders to provide input into the CIP development before the plan is adopted.
- 3. Approval of the CIP The Board of Directors shall review and approve the CIP. Amendments to the CIP shall be considered and adopted by the Board of Directors at formal board meetings except for specific adjustments when limited authority is delegated to the Fire Chief as prescribed within the Adopted Budget Resolution.
- B. CIP Project Selection An objective set of criteria will be used to assess and evaluate project proposals. Although specific criteria may be updated from time to time, the following concepts are core principles to be considered in the development of such criteria:
 - 1. Long-Term Forecasts Long-term forecasts should be prepared to better understand resources available for capital spending and to assess operational impacts and eventual maintenance replacement costs.

- c. A project is mandated by state or federal government and current revenues or fund balances are insufficient to pay project costs;
- d. A project is immediately required to meet or relieve capacity needs and existing un-programmed cash reserves are insufficient to pay project costs;
- e. Costs considered for debt financing pertain to the new assets or capital projects;
- f. The life of the project or asset financed is five years or longer; or
- g. Those expected to benefit from the project include generations in years to come.
- E. Capital Budget Each year the Fire Chief will develop a Capital Budget which will contain the spending plan for capital projects. The first year of the adopted CIP will be the Capital Budget for the fiscal year.
- F. Capital Project Management Management of capital projects is essential to create the best value for District taxpayers through capital spending. The following policies shall be observed in order to help ensure the best project management possible.
 - 1. Project Management The Fire Chief is responsible for the efficient and effective management of the CIP projects from initiation to completion including:
 - a. The development of project proposals, business cases, and/or charters as applicable.
 - b. The development of a project budget including a cash flow forecast, prior to project commencement.
 - c. The coordination and oversight of a detailed project plan including:
 - i. Actions items
 - ii. Procurements
 - iii. Risk management
 - iv. Quality control
 - v. Communication
 - d. Oversight and management of the execution of the plan ensuring that phases are completed on schedule, in scope, within budget, and to specifications; authorizing all project expenditures; monitoring project cash flows; ensuring all regulations and laws are observed; and regularly reporting project status.
 - e. Effectively completing the project including delivery of the final product and a formal review of project activities.
 - Limits on Amendments Capital Project amendments during a year may not exceed the
 annually adopted budget and funding levels unless approved by the Board of Directors.
 The Fire Chief must manage the capital program within certain time and cost constraints.
- G. Asset Condition Assessment District staff shall conduct a comprehensive asset inventory that projects replacement and maintenance needs for the next six years and will update this

Background:

Each year the district is impacted by the loss of personnel necessitating the need to hire new personnel. Annually the Captains are constantly training and oversee the needs of Probationary Firefighters. Due to this fact, and in an attempt to lighten the load on the Captains, this Mentorship Program has been instituted. The program will be reevaluated in one year to confirm its effectiveness.

Purpose:

To provide a committee of Mentors to assist Captains with Probationary Firefighters. Mentors will create a clear, additional link in the chain of command, which can oversee and provide behavior affirmations and corrections, which do not warrant the need of Officer involvement. Mentors will provide a peer that can answer basic questions and provide behavior recommendations and advice.

Policy:

An assigned Captain will oversee the Mentorship Program. Along with being assigned to a Captain, Probationary Firefighters will also be assigned an established Firefighter with no less than 2 years post probation experience. The Mentor will complete monthly evaluations of Probationary Firefighters that could include, but are not limited to assessing task-book progress, call and drill response percentage, PPE and gear rack cleanliness and overall attitude and behavior. Evaluations reports will be presented to the Probationary Firefighters and their assigned Captain. Mentors would also assist their Probationary Firefighters with training outside of drills and during drills when appropriate. Mentors would meet monthly to compare assessments of Probationary Firefighters, and to make sure that all Probationary Firefighters are progressing at a comparable rate. Mentors will also meet with the Probationary Firefighter's assigned Captain to provide a report on progress and to bring up any pertinent concerns if any exist.
